Dear U.S. Attorney Eid:

I am writing in regard to information, which has recently been reported in the news media, related to case #07-CR-00462. The case, United States of America vs. Cory Voorhis, is currently being heard in United States District Court for the District of Colorado.

As I am sure you are aware, the circumstances surrounding this case involve many people in powerful political positions here in Colorado.

In order to ensure that justice is being served, I urge you to use your authority in this matter to expand the current investigation and to appoint a special prosecutor.

Encouraging faith and trust in our judicial system requires that we apply the law equally to all of our citizens. The least powerful should have the same rights as the most powerful in our society.

By expanding the scope of your investigation to include all of the persons involved, we can ensure that the defendant in this case is not being unjustly singled out.

Just as it is important that classified government information is not allowed to be compromised, it is even more important that our justice system is not allowed to be compromised.
